The Sierra Christian Church campus is open to all. In addition to the Labyrinth, we have the Holy Ground Community Garden. The 25-plot organic garden is now the Community of Life Garden. The Placer Food Bank has severed its ties to the garden that rests on the upper portion of the church property, but the garden’s volunteers, armed with a new name and a continued commitment to what the garden can do when tended, want to keep the four plots they have worked over the years going.



On the advisement of the Board of Directors, Sierra Christian will now be the garden’s overseeing entity, the garden a new element of the church’s ongoing ministry. Sierra Christian will manage its finances and donations, and will be coordinating with the volunteers. It will be the volunteers, however, who will identify the non-profit agencies and people of need to whom the garden’s yields can be donated.
